
Note: Fabrics will be different then fabrics in your package. I recommend doing a fabric key in the colors you are using.

I like to cut my fabric out by color. You can follow the pattern and cut out as you work on a section or if you want to cut all at once, here is the breakdown (* denotes suggested cut first):


Note: There are 2 Foreground #2 pieces right together and could be cut as one piece if preferred (Piece would be 1 ½ x 6 ½)



Draw diagonal line as shown, sew and trim. Sew these pieces to together.



Sew sections together to forming 3 groups.



Continue to create these 3 groups shown. Sew the middle section, right section, and section of left shown.



Sew middle section to right section. Sew section of left section shown.



Sew 1 ½ x 13 ½ block to previously pieced left section.








Sew Schoolhouse 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ block to Roof 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$.






Draw diagonal lines. Place Trim 5 ½ x 5 ½ on top of pieced block keeping schoolhouse fabric on paying attention to angle of diagonal lines.



Draw diagonal lines. Place inside porch triangle pieces 4 ½ x 4 ½ paying attention of angle of diagonal lines.











- 1. Sew windows and schoolhouse and side schoolhouse and porch shown.
- 2. Add Schoolhouse 1 ½ x 8 ½ piece to top and bottom of windows piece (one with 4 windows).
- 3. Add Schoolhouse 1 ½ x 3 ½ to bottom of lower window sections.
- 4. Add Door in the middle of the 2 lower sections.
- 5. Combine upper schoolhouse to lower section
- 6. Add side pieces to main schoolhouse.
- 7. Add roof to schoolhouse.




















This section has a mixture of 45 degree corners and 60 degree corners. (Top of side for each side of house)


- 1. Draw diagonal lines, sew and trim.
- 2. Make two rows
- 3. Sew the rows together.
- 4. Combine step 3 with Roof 4 ½ x 3 ½ block.
- 5. Set aside to put together with rest of the blocks.












This section has a few 1" x 1" blocks that are hard to see.

There is a 1" x 1" 45 degree corner (lower tree) that should have been shown on the schoolhouse 1 ½ x 2 block. It is shown on the later blocks.

Here are the other (2) 1 x 1 blocks.

Sew together blocks shown in blue boxes in pictures 1 and 2.

- 1. Draw diagonal line, sew and trim.
- 2. After the blue boxes are sewn together, add the 45 degree corners shown in picture 2.
- 3. Sew into blue box sections shown in picture 3.
- 4. Sew red section together.
- 5. Sew the red section to the 1 ½ x 6 block noted by the blue arrow.
- 6. Sew the section created in step 5 to the schoolhouse section shown by the purple arrow.

Sew rows together.

Add top of tree block previously set aside.

This will be combined with the main schoolhouse block later.





- 1. Sew the windows to the schoolhouse $2 \% \times 2$.
- 2. Sew rows together
- 3. Sew section created in step 2 to grass $8 \% \times 3$
- 4. Sew the section created to the block previously set aside.















- 1. Draw the diagonal lines shown. Note that one of these is a 60 degree corner. Sew and trim.
- 2. Add porch 1 x 8 ½ to walkway 1 ½ x 8 ½; sew block with 60 degree corner to grass (gray on pattern) 1 ½ x 1 ½; and grass 1 ½ x 2 ½ to grass (tan on pattern) 2 ½ x 2 ½
- Add porch 2 x 1 to each side of the walkway /porch
- 4. Add the 2 x 9 ½ walkway to piece in step 3.
- 5. Finish each row shown in blue.
- 6. Sew the rows together.







Sew the block to the left and right of the main schoolhouse.

Add the top row and bottom row to the schoolhouse block previously created.
