
Note: Fabrics will be different then fabrics in your package. I recommend doing a fabric key in the colors you are using.

I like to cut my fabric out by color. You can follow the pattern and cut out as you work on a section or if you want to cut all at once, here is the breakdown (* denotes suggested cut first):










First Section:

- These are 45 degree angles.
 Draw line from corner to corner.
- 2. This one is a 60 degree corner. Offset 1/8" as shown.
- 3. Draw 45 degree lines and 60 degree lines
- 4. Sew on line and trim.
- 5. Sew 3 ½ x 3 ½ medium ocean to 1 ½ x 3 ½ light ocean together.
- 6. Sew boat 2 ½ x 4 ½ to medium ocean 2 ½ x 4 ½ together.
- 7. Sew medium ocean 3 ½ x 2 ½ to seashore 1 ½ x 2 ½ together.
- 8. Sew the blocks together.













- 1. This is a 60 degree corner.
- 2. This block has to go in order. The 2 top seashore 1 ½ x 1 ½ blocks have to be added to the corners before adding the roof 2 ½ x 2 ½.
- 3. This block also has to go in order. Add the tree 2 ½ x 2 ½ before adding roof 2 ½ x 2 ½
- 4. Do the 60 degree corners and 45 degree corners marked. Only some are marked due to some of the blocks requiring a certain order when adding corners.
- 5. Do the rest of the 45 degree corners shown.
- 6. This block is flipped in picture. It should look like a flying geese block. Left 2 ½ x 2 ½ is from the tree to right of store and right side is tree by church.





- 3. Set blocks into order shown
- 4. Combine rows to complete section.






Front view before cutting into 4 sections.


- 1. For the windows, I used a marking pencils on wrong side to measure out the grid. There is ¾" from edge to first line, then 1" width between the two lines. I trimmed right before I used them to avoid edges becoming loose.
- "General Store" was programmed into my machine. This could be handwritten with permanent ink if preferred.

















Close up of these blocks

- 1. For the highlighted block, take a 2 ½ x 2 ½ tree (next to church) and 2 ½ x 2 ½ church fence and make a diagonal line. Sew on that line and trim. Then add 1 ½ x 1 ½ grass around church to bottom right. After completing this, you will take a 2 ½ x 2 ½ tree (right side of store) and draw a diagonal line as shown. Sew and trim. Pay attention to the angles shown.
- 2. Sew store, shutter and windows as shown.
- 3. Add store 1 x 13 ½ above step 2 and 1 ½ x 13 ½ store below step 2.
- 4. Add tree block to right and left as shown to step 3.
- 5. Add top strip to step4.







- 6. Sew blocks shown together.
- 7. Add step 5 to rest of the block.
- 8. This completes the third section.







- Sew roof above and house below sign block.
- Sew tree trunk
 1 x 1 ½ to
 foreground 1 x
 4.
- Sew step 2 to foreground 2 x5.
- 4. Add tree 2 ½ x
 2 ½ to left side
 of step 3.
 Draw a
 diagonal line
 as shown and
 sew to create

6. Sew blocks together as shown combining into groups.
