
#### **General Tips:**

- 1. When following the book, an accurate ¼" seam is needed. Check you seams to make sure they are ¼" and if the ¼" is off, adjust before proceeding. Also be careful to make accurate diagonal cuts when instructed.
- 2. If you follow the instructions in the book, you are cutting on a bias edge. I suggest using starch to reduce the stretching.
- 3. Some of the fabrics had more shrinkage than others so I suggest preshrinking all the fabric. I do this by spraying the fabric completely with Best Press or your preferred brand but you could also use water. I use Best Press since it also helps with the bias edges.

#### 10" Windblown Block:

Note: Half Square Blocks should be 2 ½".

- 1. Place the center line on diagonal corners and draw a line on the edge of the ruler from either side. A ruler such as the Magic Wand or another brand can be used. If you don't have the ruler, you can draw the diagonal line then another line ½" from the center line.
- 2. Sew on the black lines and cut on the blue line (center line).
- 3. All blocks will be 2 ½" squares. Place as shown. Place blocks as shown.
- 4. Sew into 4 rows.
- 5. Sew rows together.
- 6. Sew black border to the side.
- 7. Sew the top and bottom black border.












- 1. Trace onto fusible of your choice.
- 2. Fuse the fusible to the wrong side of fabric.
- 3. Cut out the pattern and fuse to the background as shown.
- 4. Trim the background to 4 ½".








## 6" Fancy Log Cabin Block:











- 1. Sew a white multicolor square to the teal square.
- 2. Sew the white multicolor fabric rectangle to one side of the piece created in step 1 and a teal rectangle to the other side. Pay attention to the position of the piece created in step 1.
- 3. Sew a gold rectangle to the piece created in step 2.
- 4. Create 2 rows as shown.
- 5. Sew the rows together.








# 8" Courthouse Steps Block:

















- 1. Add the dark gray side strips to the center square.
- 2. Add the dark gray top and bottom strips.
- 3. Add the red side strips to the center square.
- 4. Add the red top and bottom strips.
- 5. Add the teal side strips to the center square.
- 6. Add the teal top and bottom strips.

4" Pinwheel Block: There are instructions for trimming down if preferred. If you would like to do that, cut at least 1/8" bigger than the pattern. This is optional. See Month 2.



- 1. Place the center line on diagonal corners and draw a line on the edge of the ruler from either side. A ruler such as the Magic Wand or another brand can be used. If you don't have the ruler, you can draw the diagonal line then another line  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the center line.
- 2. Sew on the black lines and cut on the blue line (center line).
- 3. Place the blocks as shown.
- 4. Sew into 2 rows.
- 5. Sew the rows together.









2" Mini Circle Block: This one is applique. Use your preferred method. The raw edge applique method and the method using Applipops is shown.



- 1. If you choose the Applipop method, choose the applipops closest to the pattern.
- 2. Place the smaller circle that matches the pattern underneath.
- 3. Place the larger circle on top.
- 4. Starch and iron excess to the middle.
- 5. Let it cool and then fuse to the background.
- 6. Trim the block to 2 ½".








## X's and O's Block: This one is shown as an O






- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the 2" red squares.
- 2. Place on opposite corners and sew on the line. TIP: Before trimming, make sure the corner lines up with the 3 ½" block.
- 3. Place as shown.
- 4. Make 2 rows.
- 5. Sew the rows together.







### 8" Saw Tooth Star Block:













- 1. For the middle section, sew dark red and pink print blocks as shown. Sew into rows and then sew the rows together.
- 2. Draw a diagonal line across the 2  $\ensuremath{\ensuremath{\mathcal{Y}}}\xspace''$  black squares.
- 3. Place on the corners of the 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " light print. Pay attention to the angles shown. Sew on the drawn line.
- 4. Iron open and place another black block as shown. Sew on the drawn line.
- 5. Place blocks as shown.
- 6. Sew into 3 rows.

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7. Sew rows together.




## 6" Checkboard Block:









- 1. Sew the yellow fabric strip to the dark fabric strip.
- 2. Cut into 18 segments.
- 3. Flipping each segment, make 9 Four Patch blocks.
- 4. Combine to make 3 rows.
- 5. Sew the rows together.
