

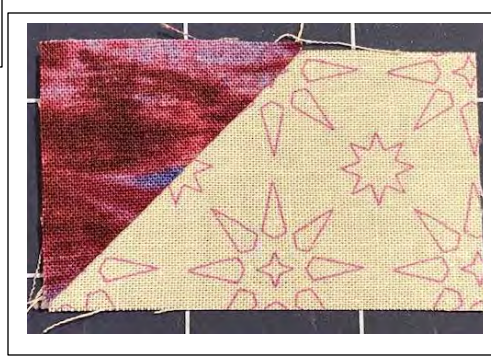

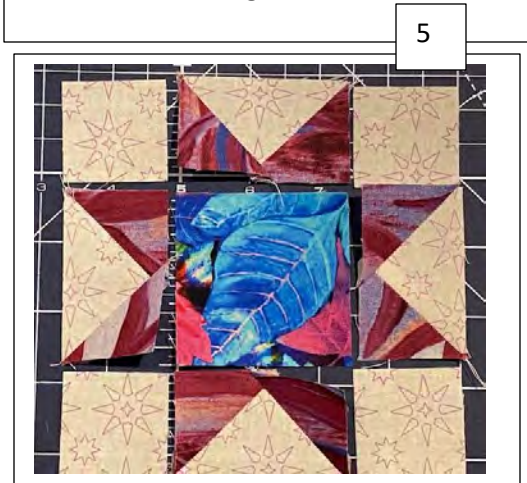
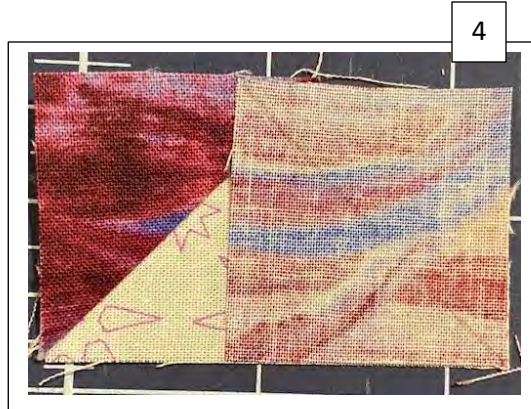
## General Tips:

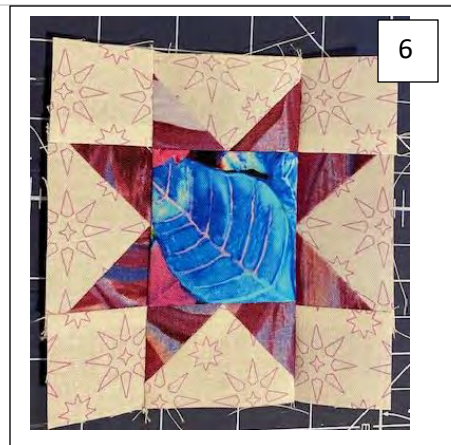
1. When following the book, an accurate  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam is needed. Check you seams to make sure they are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and if the  $\frac{1}{4}$ " is off, adjust before proceeding. Also be careful to make accurate diagonal cuts when instructed.
2. If you follow the instructions in the book, you are cutting on a bias edge. I suggest using starch to reduce the stretching.
3. Some of the fabrics had more shrinkage than others so I suggest preshrinking all the fabric. I do this by spraying the fabric completely with Best Press or your preferred brand but you could also use water. I use Best Press since it also helps with the bias edges.

## 4" Small Sawtooth Star:

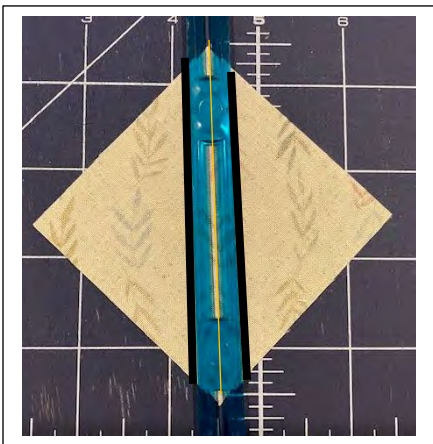


1. Draw a diagonal line on the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " bright pink squares.
2. Place on the corners on one long side of the rectangle and sew on the line on one side. Make sure you have the correct angle.
3. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the line.
4. Place the opposite square, sew on the line and trim.
5. Make 3 rows.
6. Sew the rows together.



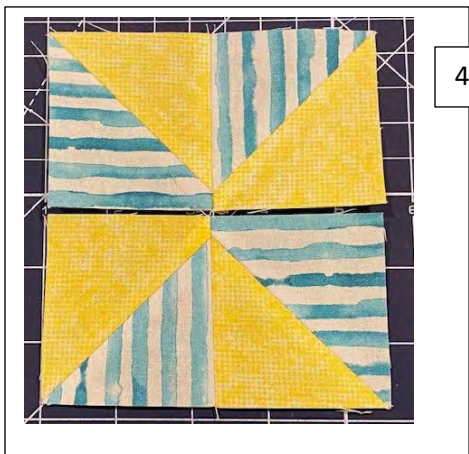
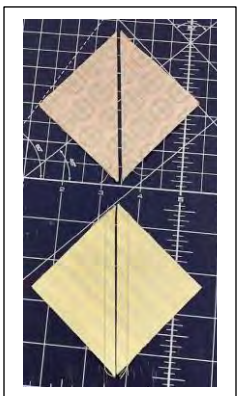


**8" Pinwheel in a Courthouse Step Block: There are instructions for trimming down if preferred. If you would like to do that, cut at least 1/8" bigger than the pattern. This is optional. See Month 2.**

1. Place the center line on diagonal corners and draw a line on the edge of the ruler from either side. A ruler such as the Magic Wand or another brand can be used. If you don't have the ruler, you can draw the diagonal line then another line 1/4" from the center line.
2. Sew on the black lines and cut on the yellow line (center line).
3. Place the blocks as shown.
4. Sew into 2 rows.
5. Sew the rows together.

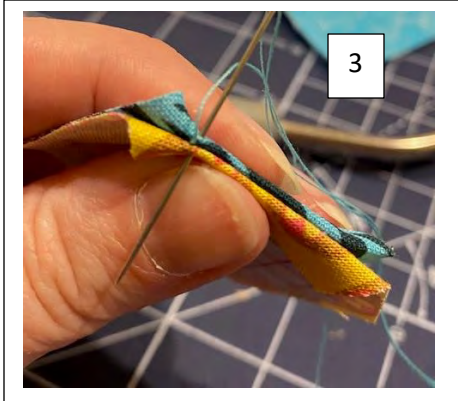
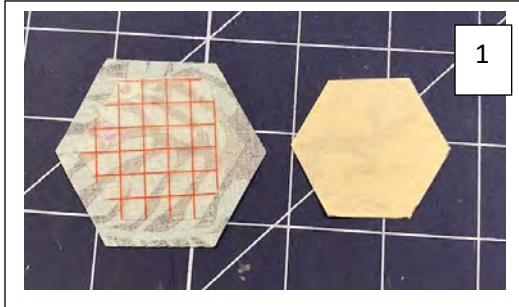

**6" Grandmother's Flower Garden:** This one is English paper piecing and then you applique to the background. Use your preferred method. Raw Edge Applique was used here due to the shape. Follow your products instructions for fusing. Hot fix fusible was used in this block.



1. Make a template using the pattern in the back. I created one with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and 7 without the seam allowance.

2. I use an iron to make the  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam crisper and easier to work with.

3. Whip the stitch from the center to the side hexagon.

4. Once you have 2 hexagons attached to the center, whip stitch the seam between the blue hexagons.

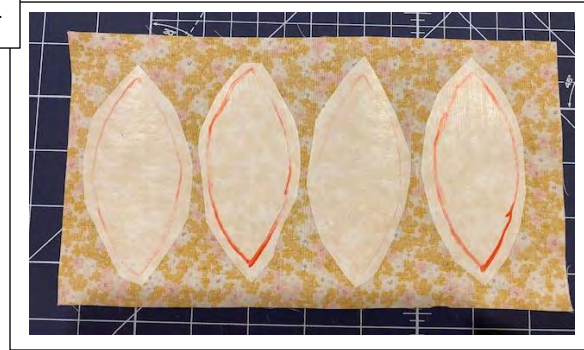
5. Applique the block to the background using your favorite stitch.



**8" Orange Peel:** This one is applique. Use your preferred method. Raw Edge Applique was used here due to the shape. Follow your products instructions for fusing. Hot fix fusible was used in this block.



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1. Trace onto fusible of your choice.

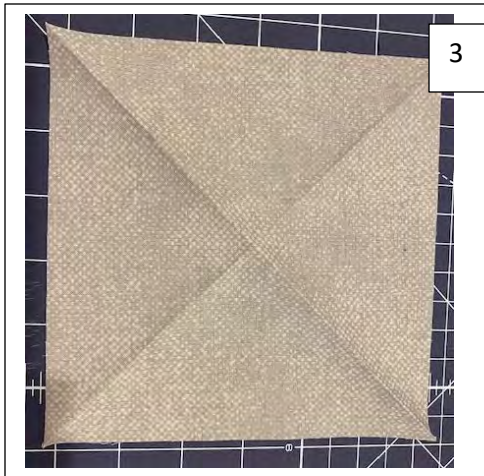
2. Fuse the fusible to the wrong side of fabric.

3. Cut out the pattern and fuse the orange peels to the background as shown. I ironed diagonal lines so that I can use the crease to match up the orange peels.

4. Center the middle circle and fuse to the block.

5. Add the side rectangles.

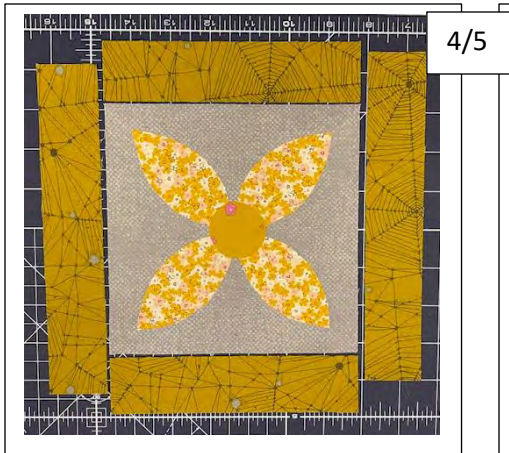
6. Add the top and bottom rectangles.



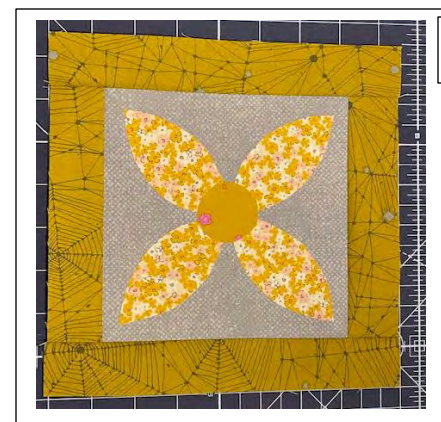
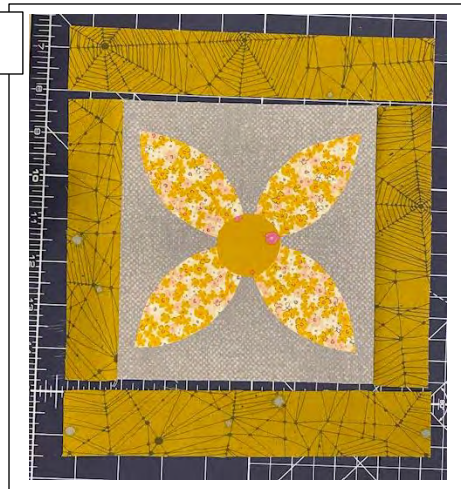
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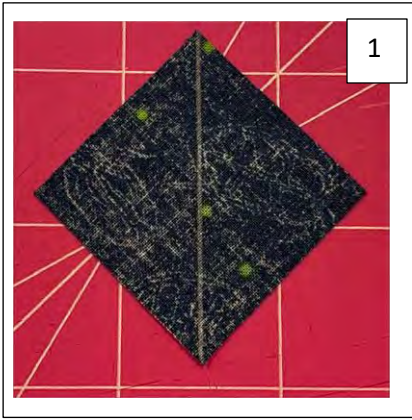


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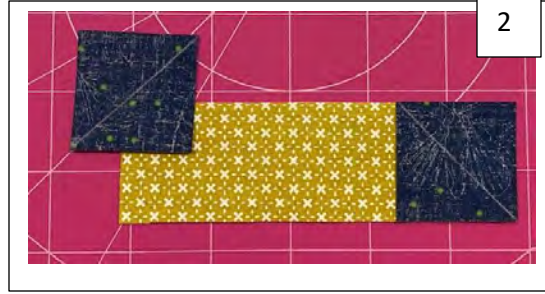


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**Spools of Thread:**

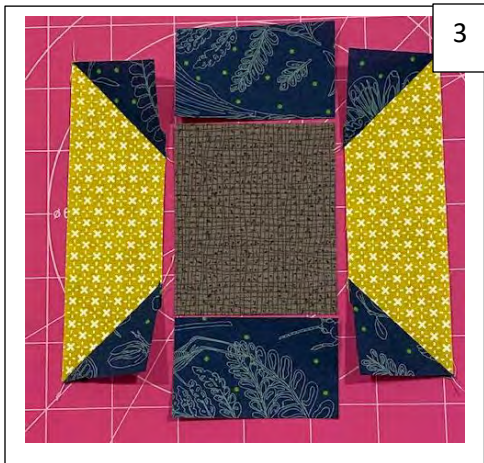


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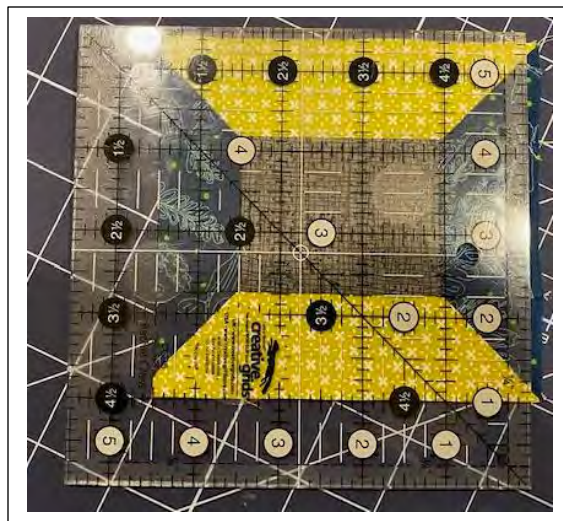
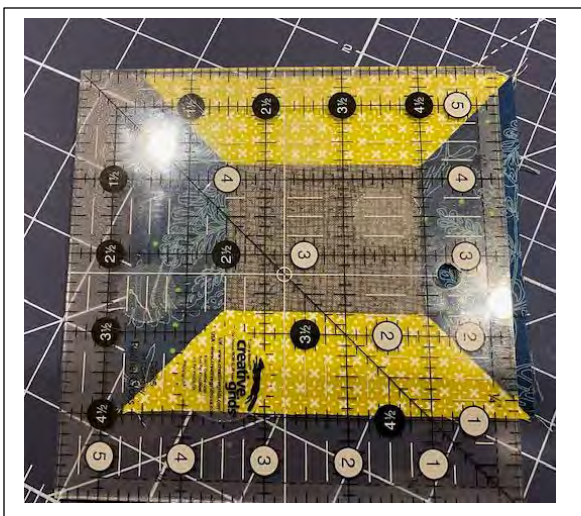
1. Draw a diagonal line on the 1 1/2" Fabric B squares.
2. Place on opposite corners and sew on the line. Make sure you have the correct angle.
3. Sew the Fabric B rectangles to opposite sides of the gray square.
4. Place as shown.
5. Make 3 columns.
6. Sew the rows together.

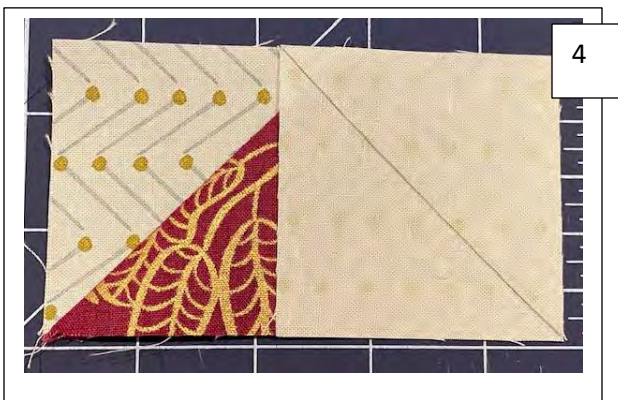
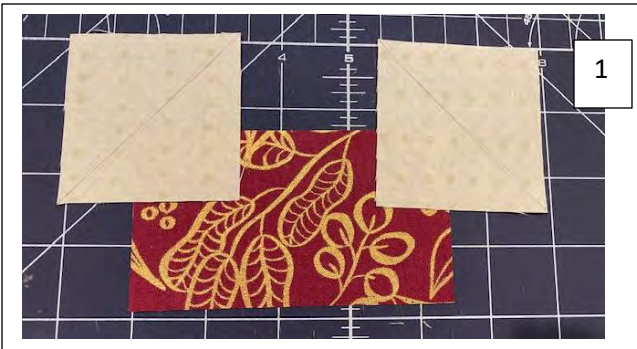
7. Trim the block to 4 1/2".

## 6" Simple Framed Square:



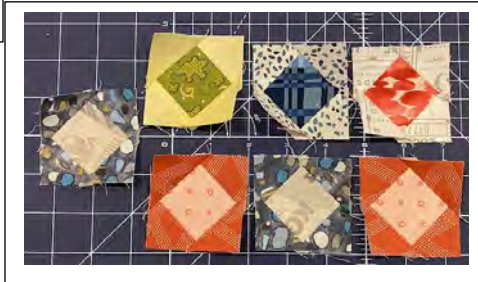
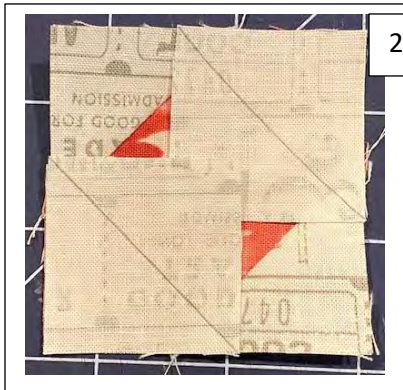
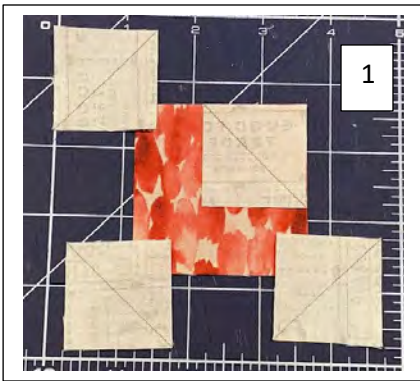
1. Add the side strips to the center square.
2. Add the top and bottom strips.

## 4" Flying Geese:



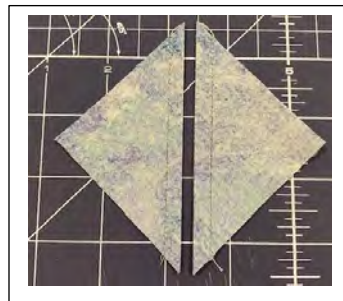
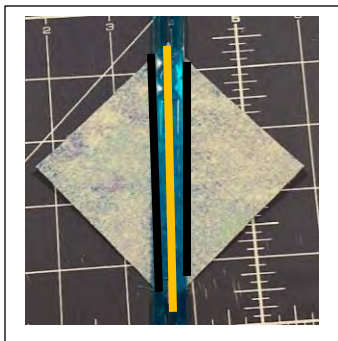
1. Draw a diagonal line on the 2 1/2" light print squares.
2. Place on the corners on one long side of the rectangle and sew on the line on one side. Make sure you have the correct angle.
3. Trim 1/4" from the line.
4. Place the opposite square, sew on the line and trim.
5. Put 2 flying geese on top of each other.
6. Sew the flying geese together.

## 2" Square in a Square Block:



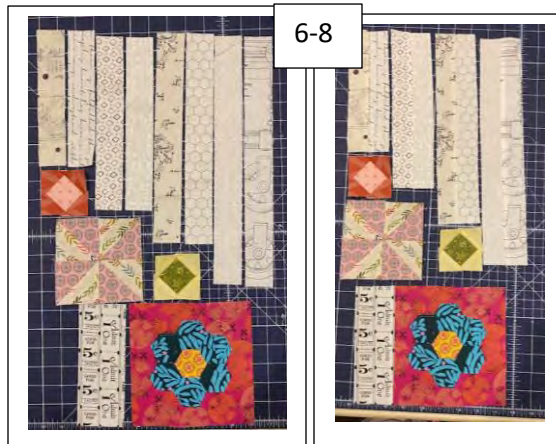
1. Draw a diagonal line on the 2 1/2" squares.
2. Place on opposite corners and sew on the line. TIP: Before trimming, make sure the corner lines up with the 2 1/2" block.
3. Repeat with remaining color combinations.

## 6" Shoo Fly:



1. Place the center line on diagonal corners and draw a line on the edge of the ruler from either side. A ruler such as the Magic Wand or another brand can be used. If you don't have the ruler, you can draw the diagonal line then another line 1/4" from the center line.
2. Sew on the black lines and cut on the yellow line (center line).
3. Place the blocks as shown.
4. Sew into 3 rows.
5. Sew the rows together.

## Putting together Section 1 and 2



1. From left side of Section 1, sew the background strips that match (from left it is 4, then 2, then 2); sew the Small Sawtooth block to the Pinwheel block; and sew the 2 rows of square in a square blocks that make a row.

2. Sew the Sawtooth Star/Pinwheel to the background set and single square in a square to the background.

3. Sew the background/Square in a Square to the set of backgrounds set.

4. Sew the two rows of square in a square rows to the filler rectangle and set created in step 3.

5. Sew the section from Step 4 to section created in step 2 and attach to Orange Peel block.

6. For the right side of Section 1, sew matching background sets together.

7. Add the Square in a Square block to the background sets shown and sew the filler to the Grandmother's Garden block.

8. Sew the background set together that match and add the pinwheel to the one on the left. Sew both sets together.

9. Add the Grandmother's Garden/filler section to step 8.

10. For Section 2, place blocks as shown.

11. Sew into 3 columns and sew the columns together.

12. Combine Section 2 with Section 1.
