The collaboration called for Carol to design the star blocks in the center of the quilt and Deb took care of the houses, buildings, and trees in the border as well as the finishing design. The finished quilt measures 97" x 97".





This pattern includes the instruction as well as the pre-printed foundation papers for the paper-pieced blocks. There are 13 months with finishing instructions included. In each month you will have a Carol Doak designed star block as well as a Deb Luttrell designed architectural item(s). You will make two of each house/tree unit for the suggested quilt layout.
