

General Tips:

- When following the book, an accurate ¼" seam is needed. Check you seams to make sure they are ¼" and if the ¼" is off, adjust before proceeding. Also be careful to make accurate diagonal cuts when instructed.
- 2. If you follow the instructions in the book, you are cutting on a bias edge. I suggest using starch to reduce the stretching.
- 3. Some of the fabrics had more shrinkage than others so I suggest preshrinking all the fabric. I do this by spraying the fabric completely with Best Press but you could also use water. I use Best Press since it also helps with the bias edges.





4. Sew blocks to pieces put together in step 2 and 3.

5. Sew the strip to the left of the square in a square block.

6. Sew the strips shown to the

9. Now that everything is in columns, sew the columns together and set aside Section 1.

10. To start Section 2, sew the matching pieces together.


11. For this piece, sew the 2 matching pieces will be sewn together and the then you will sew halfway on the piece to the


12. Sew the piece created in step 10 to the Old Maid Puzzle block.

13. Sew the square with 2 borders to the piece created on


14. Sew the piece from step 10 with 2 Square in a square to the larger square in a square with border. Then take this piece and sew it to the Pershing block.

15. Sew the left side of Section 2 with the right side.










11. Sew the partial seam shown.

12. Sew the Nurses Cross block to the piece from step 11 and finish the partial seam from step 11.

13. Sew the columns within the black box. Note: The partial seam will remain until the right side is complete.

14. Sew the 3 blocks above the black box to the black box section.

15. Finish the partial seam to complete Section 6.


24. To start Section 8, sew the matching pieces together.

25. Add the matching square to the strip pieces shown on step 24.

26. Finish the partial seam.

27. Sew columns together on first row.

28. Sew remaining rows together.



1. To start Section 9, sew the matching pieces together.

2. Add the matching square to the strip pieces shown on step 1.

3. Sew the square in a square with strips piece with the strips to the right.

4. Sew the pinwheel with border block to piece created in step 3.

5. Sew the piece created in step 4 to the strip pieces to the left.

6. Sew Hope for Hartford block to piece created in step 5.

7. Finish the partial seam.

8.Sew strip to right side of Old Maid Puzzle.

9. Sew piece from step 8 to step 7.

10. Add strip to the left side of the piece.



Finishing:



- 1. Sew Sections 9 and 8 together.
- 2. Take the section from step 1 and add Section 10.
- Sew halfway down as shown with Sections 4 and Section 7 together.
- 4. Sew the piece from step 3 to the Section 1/2/3 piece.
- 5. Sew Section 5 to the piece created in step 4.
- 6. Sew Section 6 to the piece created in step 5.
- Finish the partial seam to connect Section 7 to Section 4/6.
- Take piece from step 7 and sew it to piece created in step 2.
